3. Hardware Installation

The following sections in this chapter describe how to install BOISB-0410-00 Module

3.1. Installation Overview

BOISB-0410-00 wireless module is design for Printer only.

3.2. Safety Recommendations

The safety guidelines are as follows:

Keep the board area clear and dust-free before, during, and after installation.

Keep tools away from walk areas where you and others could fall over them.

Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry, such as earrings, bracelets, or chains, that could get caught in the board.

Wear safety glasses if you are working under any conditions that might be hazardous to your eyes.

Do not perform any action that creates a potential hazard to people or makes the equipment unsafe.

3.3. Maintaining Safety with Electricity

3.4. Installing a BOISB-0410-00

Remove the BOISB-0410-00 module from its protective packaging.

Avoiding Electrostatic Discharge

Before you install the BOISB-0410-00 module, ground yourself by touching a piece of metal to avoid electrostatic discharge (ESD). You should also take the following precautions to prevent damage to the BOISB-0410-00 module:

Keep the BOISB-0410-00 module in its antistatic-shielded bag until you are ready to install it.

Handle the BOISB-0410-00 module by its edges.

Ensure the connector is connected to above Model's board tightly.
