Using PC

Follow the steps below to access your camera via WebVUer on Internet Explorer:

- 1. Open the Internet Explorer on your Windows system.
- 2. Enter the camera's IP address in the address bar. (e.g. 192.168.0.100).
- 3. A dialog box that requests the user name and password appears; enter a valid user name and password, and then press OK. The default user name and password are both `admin.'
- 4. Meanwhile, a Windows security warning dialog box may appear. Please click [Run] to run the camera's application.
- 5. Now you can start using WebVUer on Internet Explorer to watch live video and manage your network camera.



Using Smartphone

If you have enabled the Seedonk service for your camera, you can log in to the iPhone App Store or Google Play Store on your smartphone and download the Seedonk Camera Viewer app. Then log in to the Seedonk Camera Viewer to view and manage your Compro network cameras.
