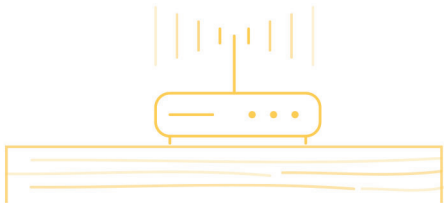




CHAT

SETTING UP

Use the Circle Home app to pair Circle with your home network. If your network has more than one router, uses a multi-band router, has its own firewall, includes network extenders, or uses advanced router settings, take a quick look at the Network Helps section of support.meetcircle.com. We want you set up right the first time.

FINDING DEVICES A HOME

Circle sees every WiFi-connected device in your home - printers, thermostats, iPads, video-streaming boxes - everything. If you want Circle to ignore some devices, make them “Unmanaged Devices” during setup rather than assigning them to a profile. If you want Circle to manage a device but aren't sure what its name is, head over to mycircle.meetcircle.com on that device and tap the image at the top right of the screen to display or hide its Device Name.

TAKING A TEST DRIVE

Once you have Circle setup, check out how it's working in your home. Select someone who has a device assigned to them and press the pause button, and then check to see if that device can get online anymore. Once you've confirmed that's working, you know Circle is managing your home. Oh, and don't forget to unpause them!

GOING FASTER

In most cases, your Circle will perform great in your home paired wirelessly with your network, so start out that way. If you notice that your network is moving a bit more slowly after installing Circle, use the Ethernet cable to connect Circle directly to your router.
