Maintaining Your DEVICE: Do not drop, throw, disassemble, crush, bend, puncture, or paint your DEVICE. Batteries: This product contains alkaline batteries. Only use new 1.5V alkaline or 1.2V NiMH rechargeable AA sized batteries. Never mix old and new batteries. Keep all of the batteries out of the reach of infants and young children. Do not open, disassemble, puncture, cut, crush, bend or shred the batteries. Do not expose to water or other liquids, fire or explosion hazard. Do not attempt to short circuit the battery by allowing metal objects to touch the battery terminals on the DEVICE, which could cause the terminals to become hot.
