Insert the Setup Wizard CD into your CD-ROM drive The Welcome screen will appear on your monitor. Click the click here to start button.



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Screen 2, Disconnect the Power from the Modem will display. After you unplug the power to your modem, click Next.

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Screen 3, Disconnect the Modern from your Computer will display. After you disconnect the cable that connects your modem to the computer, click Next.



Screen 4, Connect the Modern to the Router will display. After you plug the cable that you just disconnect from your computer into the router's internet port, click Next.



Screen 5, *Connect the Power to the Modern* will display. After you plug in the power to your modern, click **Next.** 



Screen 6, *Connect the Router to the Computer* will display. Your Router came with a blue network cable. Plug one end of the blue network cable into your computer's network port, then click **Next**.



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Screen 7, *Connect the Router to the Computer* will display. Plug the end of the blue network cable into any of the Router's ports that are numbered 1 to 4. When you are finished, click **Next**.



Screen 8, *Connect the Power to the Router* will display. Using the power adapter that came with the Router, plug it into the Router's Power port. Plug the other end into an electrical outlet.



**IMPORTANT:** Make sure you use the power adapter that is supplied with the Router. Use of a different power adapter could damage the Router.

Screen 9, *Check the Lights on the Router*, will display. On the Router's front panel, the Power, Internet and at least one of the numbered (1,2,3 or 4) LEDs should be on. If not, make sure the cables are securely connected. If the lights are still not lit, you can click on the **Review Instructions** button, to make sure all the connections are correct. After the Power, Internet and at least one of the numbered (1,2,3 or 4) LEDs are lit, click **Next**.

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Continue to follow the Setup Wizard's on-screen instructions to to set up your Internet connection and wireless settings. When you have successfully finished setting up the Router you will see the *Congratulations!* screen.
